We hope you and your student(s) have had a great year! As the year comes to a close and we plan for final assessments the week of June 6 - 10, we also want to inform you of the following schedule changes:

There will not be Chapel on Wednesday, June 1. Instead, high school students are required to be in Chapel dress for the High School Awards Assembly on Thursday, June 2. Seniors are not required to attend classes on June 2, but are required to check in with the Secondary Office between 12:10 and 12:30 for the Awards Assembly. If seniors choose to arrive before 12:10, they will need to report to class. Enclosed is the modified class schedule for June 2 for your reference.

The Senior Store will continue serving regular menu items through Tuesday, June 7, but will be closed on Thursday and Friday, June 2 and 3 due to the HS Awards Assembly and Senior Graduation Practice. Students will need to bring lunches from home and microwaves and hot water will be available for student use on June 2 and 3.

A schedule of the exam/assessment dates and times is provided below for your reference. Teachers will provide students with specific assessment details regarding the anticipated length of the assessment within the designated 105 minute exam period and how to most effectively prepare to demonstrate their learning. Please pray for your child and our entire student body as they anticipate finals week!

Each half-day will begin 10 minutes later than usual at 7:55 a.m. and students will be dismissed for the day at 11:45 a.m. It is imperative that students arrive to school on time.

Except for Tuesday, two final exams will be given each day with a break between them. We encourage you to send healthy snacks to school with your student for the break every day. The student store will be open during break if students would prefer to purchase a snack.

To provide our students with a protected and equitable test environment during finals week, please review these expectations:

<u>Attendance</u>: Students are expected to be in school for all final exams. Vacations, appointments or other activities that would prevent students from attending school should not be scheduled. Attendance will be taken and regular attendance procedures will apply.

Students who have a Study Hall or TA class will be permitted to arrive on campus after their scheduled Study Hall/TA period, or leave campus before their scheduled Study Hall/TA period. However, regular attendance procedures will apply and students will be expected to be in class if they are on campus. Students with a 1st period Study Hall/TA may be dismissed at the end of 7th period on Tuesday, June 7. All students wanting to arrive late or leave early due to a Study Hall/TA period will be required to complete and turn in to the Secondary Office the enclosed Permission Form. Students must stop by the office when signing in or checking out.

<u>Classes will not be disturbed</u> at any time during final exams. In fairness and respect to all students please do not request to have your child released from school. Teachers have been instructed not to allow students to leave classes early or to enter the classroom once the exam has started. Disruptions impact students' assessment performance. Your support is greatly appreciated. Students have been advised of these expectations as well.

<u>Dress code:</u> Students are expected to follow dress code. Sweats or loungewear are not appropriate.

Students should come prepared with reading or study materials: All students will be expected to remain quietly in their classes for the duration of the testing period so that those students needing the entire class time to complete their exams are not disturbed.

<u>Cell phones and electronic devices</u> are strictly prohibited in all classes. Students should not be making phone calls or sending text messages from their classes asking for you to give them permission to leave the class because they are finished with a final. Phone calls may be made between classes or during the break only.

<u>All students must be picked up at 11:45</u>: There is no after-school supervision provided for secondary students on half days. Please make prior arrangements to ensure your student has after-school transportation June 8 - 10.
