## **HIGH SCHOOL INTERSCESSION IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- InterSCession 2012 will take place the week of April 2 6.
- InterSCession participation is <u>mandatory</u> for all high school students.
- All students must attend all day, every day.
- Attendance is recorded just like a regular school week, roll taken each day.
- Vacations/planned absences during the week of InterSCession are highly discouraged.
  - o In the rare case of an absence, make up is mandatory for any student missing any time during InterSCession for *any reason*.
  - Make up is (6) hours per full day missed or hour-to-hour missed of pre-approved community service under the direction of the InterSCession Coordinator.
  - Make up work must be pre-approved by Mrs. Tripoli (please note: regular church volunteer service is not accepted.)
  - o Written proof of completion must be turned in within 30 days of InterSCession.
  - Please keep in mind that it is difficult to make-up any time missed. Students who have missed InterSCession time usually have to do more work to make up the time than they would have had they completed all of their hours during the scheduled week of InterSCession.
  - o Failure to makeup time missed will result in final report cards being withheld.

## **InterSCession Attendance Procedures:**

Attendance for the week of InterSCession is recorded just like a regular school week and will be taken each day. Please follow regular school attendance procedures during the week of InterSCession. To help us account for each student on a daily basis, please report your student's absence to the secondary office before his/her group departs for the day through one of the following options:

## Other Information for the week of April 2 – 6:
